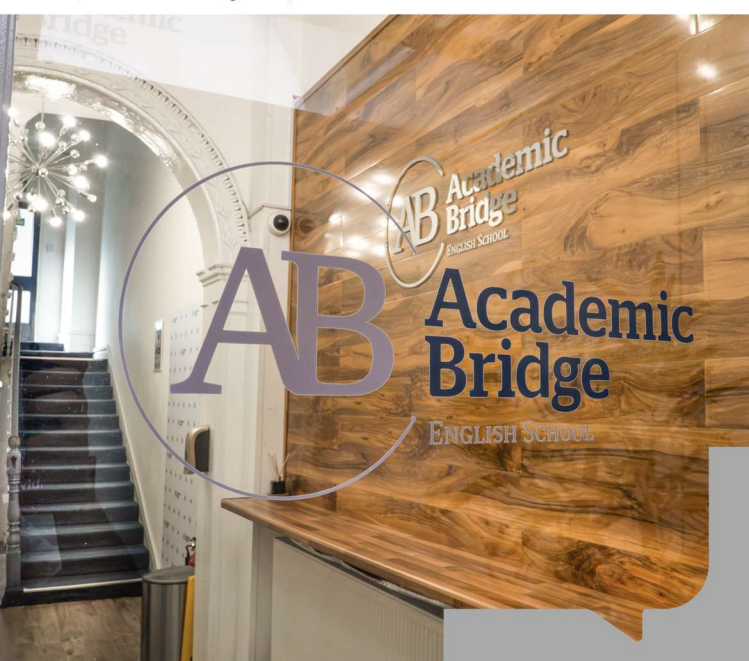

The island of Ireland consists of 26 counties of the Republic of Ireland, and 6 counties of Northern Ireland, which is part of the United Kingdom. The Republic and Northern Ireland amount to one continuous landmass.

The Irish language is the official first language of the state, although the majority of Irish people speak English as their first language. There are still pockets of Irish speaking areas, called Gaeltachts, mainly along the western seaboard and the southwest, but there are still some communities remaining that are monolingual in Irish alone. All road signs and official documents are written in both Irish and English.

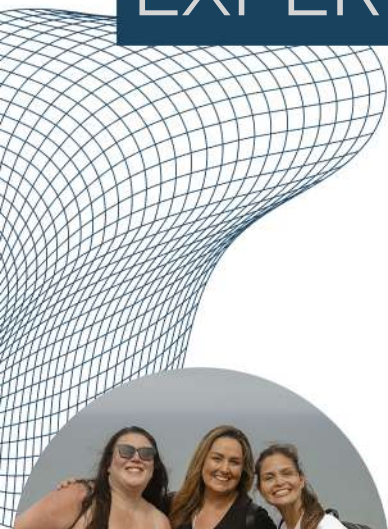

GENERAL ENGLISH 15h (GE15)

With the main focus of our general english course is the practice of communication skills, this course also provides a solid foundation in conversation and the main linguistic skills such as reading, writing, listening and speaking. There is a core course book and workbook, which are supplemented by teachers with authentic materials such as newspapers, magazines, menus, manuals, brochures and a range of other sources.

- The student can understand and use very basic everyday expressions and simple phrases related to personal needs.

The student can introduce him/herself and others, and ask and answer simple questions about personal details such as where he/she lives or people he/she knows.

- The student can interact in a very simple way, provided the other person speaks slowly and clearly and is willing to help.

At this level, you can:

- The student can understand simple sentences and commonly used expressions related to everyday situations.

The student can communicate in basic, familiar contexts using simple language and short exchanges.

- The student can describe basic personal information, daily routines, and immediate needs in simple terms.

(CEFR A2)

At this level, you can:

- The student can understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to areas of immediate relevance such as work, shopping, and daily life.

The student can communicate in simple and routine tasks requiring a direct exchange of information on familiar matters.

- The student can describe aspects of his/her background, immediate environment, and basic experiences using simple language.

At this level, you can:

- The student can understand the main points of clear standard input on familiar topics regularly encountered at **work, study, or leisure.**

- The student can produce simple connected text on familiar topics and describe experiences, events, and plans **with** reasons and explanations.

INTERMEDIATE PLUS (CEFR B1+)

At this level, you can:

- The student can understand the main ideas of longer texts and discussions on familiar and some unfamiliar topics.
- The student can interact with reasonable fluency and confidence in everyday and work-related situations.
- The student can produce more detailed connected text and express opinions with some supporting detail.

UPPER- INTERMEDIATE (CEFR B2)

At this level, you can:

- The student can understand the main ideas of complex texts on both concrete and abstract topics, including discussions in his/her field of interest.
- The student can interact with a degree of fluency and spontaneity that makes regular interaction with proficient speakers possible without strain.
- The student can produce clear, detailed text on a wide range of subjects and explain viewpoints, giving advantages and disadvantages of options.

- The student can understand with ease virtually everything heard or read.
- The student can summarise information from different spoken and written sources, reconstructing arguments in a coherent presentation.
- The student can express him/herself spontaneously, very fluently, and precisely, conveying fine shades of meaning even in complex situations.

These examinations evaluate the four core language skills — reading, writing, speaking, and listening — through an integrated approach that reflects how English is used in real-life communication.

Trinity ISE (Integrated Skills in English)



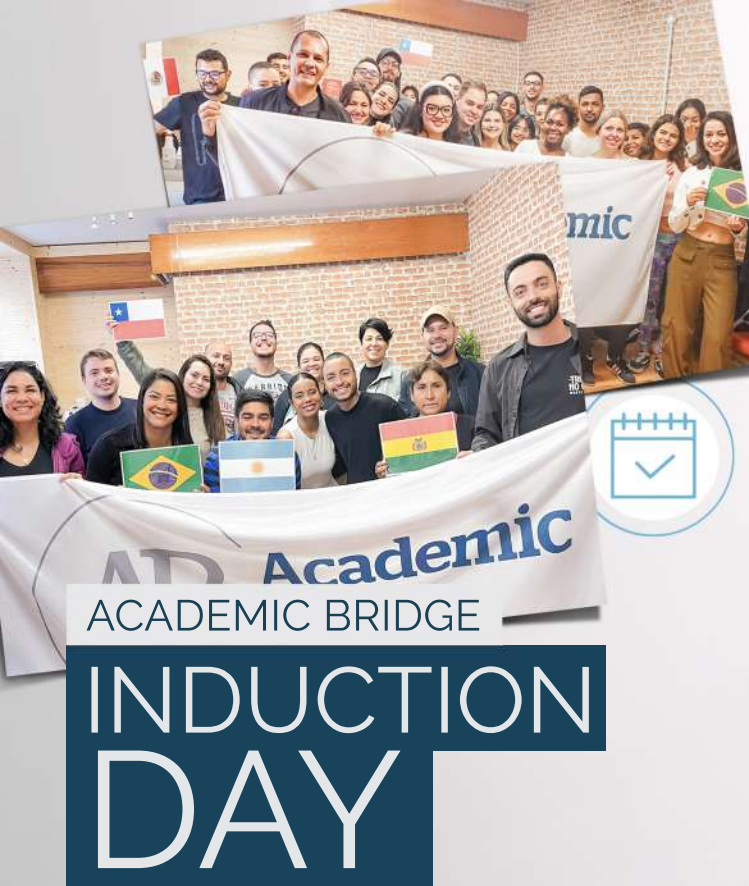
